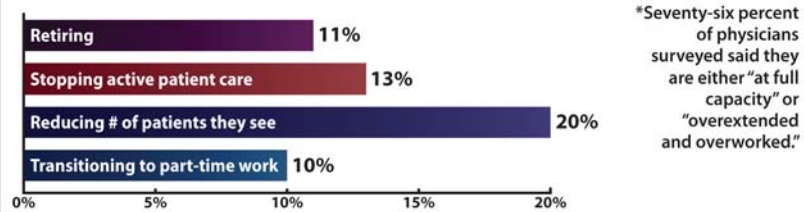


Great Time to Be a DC
