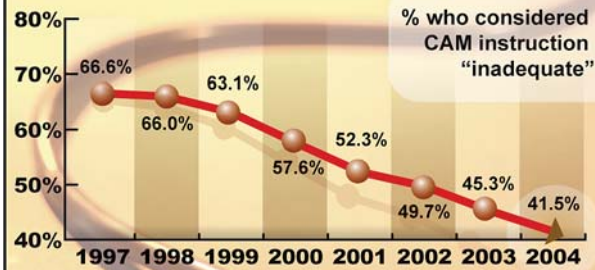


Med School Grads: Time Devoted to CAM Instruction “Inadequate”

According to an annual survey of medical school graduates (1997-2004), many consider their training in complementary and alternative medicine (CAM) “inadequate.” While the percentage of graduating doctors “undereducated in CAM” has declined, it’s obvious there’s still work to do:*
