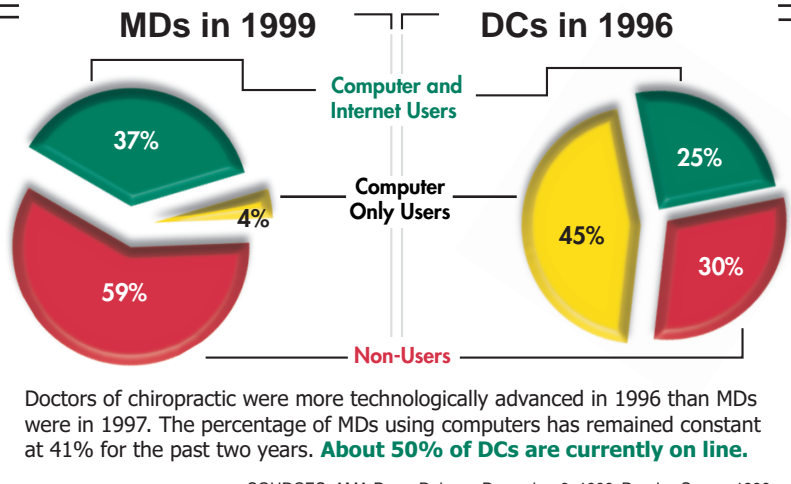


Medical Doctors Learning the Web

In a recent press release, the AMA bragged that Internet use among MDs had "nearly doubled" from 20% in 1997. How does this compare to the most recent figures for doctors of chiropractic:



Doctors of chiropractic were more technologically advanced in 1996 than MDs were in 1997. The percentage of MDs using computers has remained constant at 41% for the past two years. **About 50% of DCs are currently on line.**
