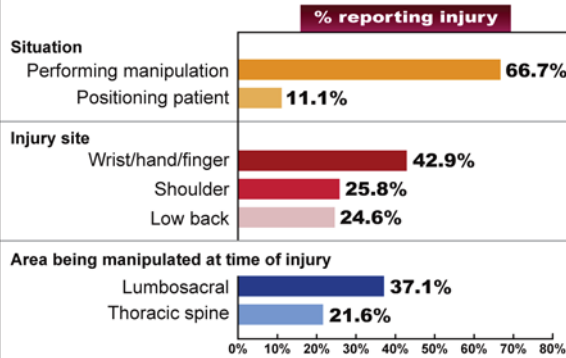


When a Doctor Needs a Doctor

Results of a recent study provide insight into the types of injuries doctors of chiropractic experience while caring for patients. Note the most common situations leading to an injury, the most frequently injured anatomical region, and the patient site being manipulated at the time the DC sustained the injury. Interestingly, nearly 40 percent of injuries occurred during the first five years of practice.
