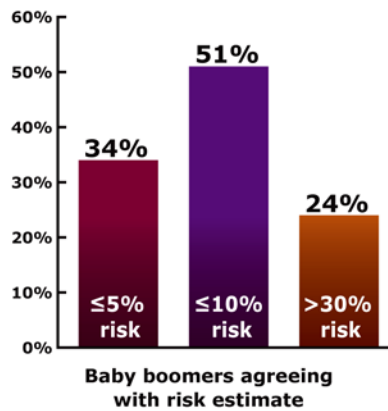


Baby Boomers And Disability Risk

A recent survey from Harris Interactive suggests baby boomers severely underestimate the risk that a typical working adult will miss three or more consecutive months of work due to illness or injury:
