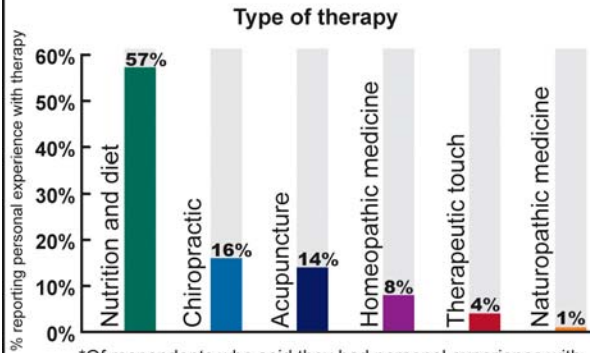


## Medical School Faculty Endorse Chiropractic
