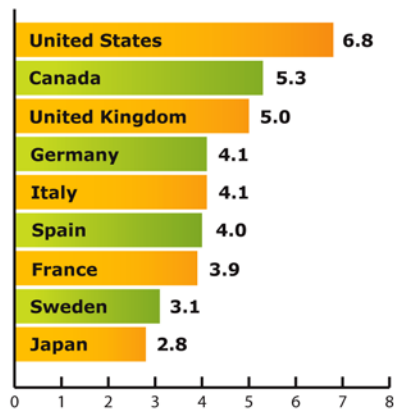


If We Can't Keep Our Children Healthy...
