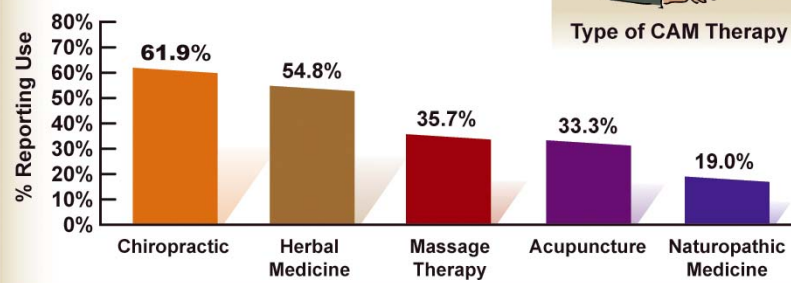


CAM USE BY THE ELDERLY:

CHIROPRACTIC COMES FIRST

A survey of North American senior citizens (66-100 years of age) assessed the prevalence of complementary and alternative medicine use in the elderly population. Among participants who reported current or previous CAM utilization, chiropractic was the most frequently used therapy.
